Food Service Manager: This course is designed to prepare students for the Association of Nutrition and Foodservice Professionals (ANFP) Credentialing Examination. Clinical (Hands-on) Experience

Field experience portion is 150 hours and is coordinated by a Registered Dietitian. Qualified students can have reduced hours, talk with Cindra Holland.

Students are responsible for the cost of the DMA exam (\$395). Next exam date: March 31, 2012.

Prerequisites:

- Pre-entrance Exam - \$30
- High School Diploma or GED
- Present BCI (fingerprinting) background check
- Word, Excel, & PowerPoint computer courses are recommended during or after completion of the DMT course to improve job placement. Penta Adult Education has an introduction to computer course that combines all three Microsoft Office programs, which is geared just for the DMT student.
