Clinical (Hands-on) Experience

Field experience portion is 150 hours and is coordinated by a Registered Dietitian.

Tuition: \$2,650 (Includes books, all courses above, lab coat, and review and prep for CDM, CFPP pre-exam study intensive 1-day course)

Tuition is due at registration and monthly payments are available. Please register one (1) week prior to start date.

Students are responsible for the cost of the DMA exam (\$375)

Prerequisites:

- *Pre-entrance Exam - \$30*
- *High School Diploma or GED*
- *Present BCI (fingerprinting) background check with no criminal history*
- *Word, Excel, & PowerPoint computer courses are recommended during or after completion of the DMT course to improve job placement. Penta Adult Education has an introduction to computer course that combines all three Microsoft Office programs, which is geared just for the DMT student.*
